The memorial dedication at 1 pm is the culminating event for a Boy Scout Eagle project by Aaron Bratina of Boy Scout Troop 324, sponsored by American Legion Post 101. Mr. Leonard, a Winlock native, was shot down and subsequently captured during the Vietnam War. He was incarcerated in the Hanoi Hilton alongside Senator John McCain for over 4 years. Mr. Leonard passed away this past Veterans Day. Coincidentally, this memorial is being placed on property which was originally homesteaded by his great grandfather...and is now the post home for Post 101 and VFW Post 3409.
