Veteran Conservation Corps Crew Positions

Tacoma-based military veteran crews are inclusive and team-oriented. Project sites include spectacular Olympic National Park, rugged Pacific Coast beaches and the remarkable shoreline of Puget Sound.

- ▶ Use of ATVs, mid-sized boats, and small power equipment (training provided)
- ▶ Potential deployment for disaster response (state and nationwide)
- ▶ \$2,775 AmeriCorps Education Award
- ▶ Hard physical work in all weather conditions
- ▶ Paid technical training (career-oriented certifications)
- ▶ Living allowance equal to minimum wage (\$9.32/hour)

Position will be required to take part in Beach cleanup, removing creosote-treated and petroleum-derived debris as well as trail construction and environmental restoration plantings. Position is a 6-month 40 hour/week commitment, with a living allowance. AmeriCorps education award is also available upon completion of 6 month commitment. Position is eligible for basic health insurance, training in career oriented certifications and a chance to network with environmental professional's state wide.
